

☆ ILLINOIS STAR OF TOMORROW AWARD ☆

The Illinois State USBC Association offers scholarships each year to reward outstanding youth bowlers, provided they meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 1. Candidates must be amateur as defined by USBC. Only those who have not bowled for money or merchandise prizes in accordance with USBC eligibility rule 400 are eligible.
- 2. The applicant must be 14-17 years of age as of August 1, 2023. USBC members only.
- 3. Awards are given in the amounts of 1st \$1500; 2nd \$1000; and 3rd place \$750 each for male and female.
- 4. Applicants who place 2nd or 3rd may reapply until they win. Once, you have won you are not eligible to apply again.
- 5. Applicant must have been a USBC member in Illinois for four years.
- 6. Additional funds may be awarded to male and female recipients.
- 7. Judging is based equally on bowling accomplishments, scholastic abilities, and community involvement.
