



☆ ILLINOIS STAR OF TOMORROW AWARD ☆

The Illinois State USBC Association offers scholarships each year to reward outstanding youth bowlers, provided they meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Candidates must be amateur as defined by USBC. Only those who have not bowled for money or merchandise prizes in accordance with USBC eligibility rule 400 are eligible.
2. The applicant must be 14-17 years of age as of August 1, 2024. USBC members only.
3. Awards are given in the amounts of 1st \$1500; 2nd \$1000; and 3rd place \$750 each for male and female.
4. Applicants who place 2nd or 3rd may reapply until they win. Once, you have won you are not eligible to apply again.
5. Applicant must have been a USBC member in Illinois for four years.
6. Additional funds may be awarded to male and female recipients.
7. Judging is based equally on bowling accomplishments, scholastic abilities, and community involvement.
