**NOTE: USBC requires an individual to have a 2024-25 Junior Gold membership to qualify for the 2025 tournament. While we will not be charging a fee to attempt to qualify, those who wish to MUST purchase a 2024-25 Junior Gold Membership prior to bowling. This can be done 'online' at https://www.bowl.com/Junior_Gold/Junior_Gold_Home/Membership after May 1, 2024. If this is done at the last minute we will need the confirmation you should be able to print of purchasing such. The Junior Gold department posts a new membership list every Thursday. Individuals who do not submit membership payment to
us must be on this list or you will be required to purchase a membership onsite or bring up an already purchased membership on your phone.

RULES
This is a SCRATCH Tournament
and will be played on a USBC Sport Condition

1 This is a USBC Youth certified tournament. All participants must be a current member of the Illinois USBC Youth Assn. Your current USBC Youth Membership card along with proof of 2024-25 Junior Gold membership (if you are a JG member and desire to be included in the Junior Gold portion of this event) will be required at check-in.
2 Check in will begin at 9:30am Saturday June 1, 2024, Town and Country Lanes, Joliet, IL.
3 Multiple entries are not permitted.
4 Tournament is limited to a total field of 160
5 Mail in entries will close May 30, 2024. Walk-in entries will be accepted in each division and are subject to a $\$ 5.00$ late fee.
6 Bowlers are required to wear suitable attire while bowling in the All Star Shootout. Bowling shoes must be worn. Participants must be neat in both clothing and personal grooming and meet the following dress code rules:

## $\Rightarrow \quad$ What is allowed

- Shirts
- Athletes must wear shirts that have a collar such as golf or polo shirts.
- Mock collar shirts will be allowed if imprinted with a bowling logo.
- The only t-shirts that will be allowed are those that have the bowling center or sponsor's names on it or the official USBC Youth Jersey.
- Souvenir shirts purchased at the State Team or PEPSI State/Zone souvenir table can also be worn.
- Lower Body Apparel
- Male participants may wear slacks, jeans or "walking/golf style shorts. Slacks must not contain drawstring waists or elastic bottoms.
- Female participants may wear slacks, dress jeans, skirts, culottes, skorts or walking shorts. All skirts, culottes, skorts, or walking shorts must be no shorter than one-half the distance from the inseam to the top of the knee in length and/or no shorter than the fingertips when the arms are at their sides while standing What is NOT allowed
- Spandex, sweatpants, pants with draw strings
- Pants with holes in them and/or in poor repair or those made out of parachute-like material.
- T-shirts other than what is stated above.
- Chains on clothing while bowling.
- Leather clothing including jackets while bowling.
- Headgear (hats, bandannas, headbands, etc.)
- Advertisements on apparel or bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling and/or inappropriate language/gestures during tournament competition may result in disqualification from the tournament.


## Any exceptions to the above must be approved by the tournament management prior to check-in.

7 The Tournament Manager will enforce these guidelines and questionable apparel must be referred to the Tournament Manager or designee before it is worn. Bring alternative clothing that follows the dress code in case approval is denied. Failure to comply with any dress code rule may result in disqualification from the tournament.
8 All bowling will be SCRATCH and on a Sport Complying Condition. Boys and Girls will be in separate age based divisions. Boys and Girls will bowl together on the same lanes.
9 You DO NOT need to be a Junior Gold Member to participate in this event. However, the Top JG Boy and the Top JG Girl in each division will be awarded a 2025 Junior Gold spot (site to TBD). JG membership entails having a 2024-25 Junior Gold membership. See note on other side for more information on this. You WILL NOT be able to purchase a Junior Gold Membership after competition begins. If there are fewer than 4 JG members in any division, there cannot be an advancer from that division (USBC requires at least four in a competition to advance someone).
10 Lane assignments will be given out at check-in. Players will be advised of lane rotations based on the number of bowlers and lanes used. Current COVID (if any) mitigations that may be in place for the tournament must be followed.
11 Ties for any spot will be decided by high scratch game bowled during 8 game competition.
12 Any rules not covered here will fall under the 2023-2024 USBC Rule Book. The tournament Committee will be responsible for all final decisions.
13 All scholarships will be held by the USBC S.M.A.R.T. Program. Scholarship fees will be returned 100\% based on ratio 1:10 minimum.
14 Note: The top12 year old (or younger) boy \& girl placing below the regular prize list will receive a scholarship.
