Scholarships will be awarded on a 1:5 ratio and be placed in the ILUSBC's SMART FUND.

FORMAT: 3 team members contribute frames (bowler 1 = frames 1,4,7,10; bowler 2 = frames 2,5,8 ; bowler 3 = 3,6,9) for one game of bowling. You will bowl 2 games on your starting lane, then rotate with the team on your pair for another 2 games after which you will move one pair to the right and repeat 4 more games, then move one more time to pair on right and repeat 4 more games. Will be bowling 12 baker games total. Order of bowlers may be switched upon the completion of any game.

*Handicap division may be any combination of bowlers. Ex: 3 girls, 3 boys or mixed boys/girls.

BAKER TRIOS RULES
**** IMPORTANT ** ENTRANTS READ THOROUGHLY**

1. All bowlers **MUST** be a certified USBC Youth member. Check-in starts 45 minutes before squad time.
2. Entries will be accepted until squad time depending on the availability of lanes. Paid reservations preferred. Reservations for paid entries will be held until 15 minutes before squad times **OR WALK-INS WILL BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO BOWL.**
3. There are five divisions: Handicap (3 girls, 3 boys or mixed), Scratch Boys, Scratch Girls, Scratch Mixed and Handicap Adult/Youth. May multiple participate by switching one bowler. Adult/Youth Division consists of one certified Adult bowler and two certified youth bowlers.
4. This tournament is based on last year's 2023-2024 highest league average with a minimum of 21 games. Handicap Division is 90% of 200. All bowlers **MUST** provide a league standing sheet or individual average sheet of last season's ending average along with entry if their average is not posted on bowl.com to ensure that everyone is given the proper handicap. (certified summer averages included). If bowler doesn't have an average from last year, bowler will use their current average with a minimum of 15 games and provide a league standing sheet for verification. Bowlers who don't have an average cannot bowl handicap. Falsification of average verification will result in disqualification from the tournament. High school averages are not certified averages and cannot be accepted.
5. Multiple participation is allowed, see rule #3.
6. **FORMAT:** Each squad will consist of a 12 game baker block. Three team members contribute frames (bowler 1 = frames 1,4,7,10; bowler 2 = frames 2,5,8 ; bowler 3 = 3,6,9) for one game of bowling. You will bowl 2 games on your starting lane, then rotate with the team on your pair for another 2 games after which you will move one pair to the right and repeat 4 more games, then move one more time to the pair on the right and repeat 4 more games. Order of bowlers may be switched upon the completion of any game. Teams will consist of 3 bowlers.
7. Scholarships will be given for 1 out of every 5 entries in the divisions to be placed at USBC SMART Fund. Standings will be posted on the website ilusbcyouth.org. All "scholarship fees" will be returned 100 percent.
8. No use of tobacco products, alcohol or drugs, etc. will be permitted during the tournament. This is a smoke/alcohol free environment.
9. **All other USBC rules will apply. The decision of the tournament director/s shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.**
10. **Premature termination of the tournament brought about by reason beyond the control of the ILLINOIS STATE USBC shall cause the prize awards to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in the tournament up to the time of termination.**
11. **DRESS CODE:** Dress slacks, dress shorts, skort or jeans with either a collared shirt (mock or butterfly) or bowling center t-shirt are encouraged. Dress slacks and dress shorts are defined as pants with a button/snap and zipper. **NO** sweatpants, yoga pants or spandex permitted.
