# ILLINOIS ALL-STAR \*\*\*SHOOT OUT\*\*\* RULES



This is a **SCRATCH** Tournament and will be played on a **USBC Sport Condition**

- 1 This is a USBC Youth certified tournament. All participants must be a current member of the Illinois USBC Youth Assn. Your current USBC Youth Membership card along with proof of 2021-22 Junior Gold membership (if you are a JG member and desire to be included in the Junior Gold portion of this event) will be required at check-in.
- 2 Check in will begin at 9:30am Saturday June 5, 2021, Town and Country Lanes, Joliet, IL.
- 3 Multiple entries are not permitted.
- 4 Tournament is limited to a total field of 160
- 5 Mail in entries will close May 30, 2021. Walk-in entries will be accepted in each division and are subject to a \$5.00 late fee.
- 6 Bowlers are required to wear suitable attire while bowling in the All Star Shootout. Bowling shoes must be worn. Participants must be neat in both clothing and personal grooming and meet the following dress code rules:

⇒ **What is allowed**

• **Shirts**

- Athletes must wear shirts that have a collar such as golf or polo shirts.
- Mock collar shirts will be allowed if imprinted with a bowling logo.
- The only t-shirts that will be allowed are those that have the bowling center or sponsor's names on it or the official USBC Youth Jersey.
- Souvenir shirts purchased at the State Team or PEPSI State/Zone souvenir table can also be worn.

• **Lower Body Apparel**

- Male participants may wear slacks, jeans or "walking/golf style shorts. Slacks must not contain drawstring waists or elastic bottoms. Jeans are not permitted.
- Female participants may wear slacks, dress jeans, skirts, culottes, skorts or walking shorts. All skirts, culottes, skorts, or walking shorts must be no shorter than one-half the distance from the inseam to the top of the knee in length and/or no shorter than the fingertips when the arms are at their sides while standing

**What is NOT allowed**

- Blue jeans, Spandex, sweatpants, pants with draw strings
- Pants with holes in them and those made out of parachute-like material.
- T-shirts other than what is stated above.
- Chains on clothing while bowling.
- Leather clothing including jackets while bowling.
- Headgear (hats, bandannas, headbands, etc.)
- Advertisements on apparel or bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling and/or inappropriate language/gestures during tournament competition may result in disqualification from the tournament.

**Any exceptions to the above must be approved by the tournament management prior to check-in.**

- 7 The Tournament Manager will enforce these guidelines and questionable apparel must be referred to the Tournament Manager or designee before it is worn. Bring alternative clothing that follows the dress code in case approval is denied. Failure to comply with any dress code rule may result in disqualification from the tournament.
- 8 All bowling will be SCRATCH and on a Sport Condition. Boys and Girls will be in separate age based divisions.
- 9 You DO NOT need to be a Junior Gold Member to participate in this event. However, the Top JG Boy and the Top JG Girl in each division will be awarded a 2022 Junior Gold spot (site to TBD). JG membership entails having a 2021-22 Junior Gold membership. See note on other side for more information on this. You WILL NOT be able to purchase a Junior Gold Membership after competition begins. If there are fewer than 4 JG members in any division, there cannot be an advancer from that division (USBC requires at least four in a competition to advance someone).
- 10 Lane assignments will be given out at check-in. Players will be advised of lane rotations based on current COVID mitigations that will be in place for the tournament.
- 11 Ties for any spot will be decided by high scratch game bowled during 8 game competition.
- 12 Any rules not covered here will fall under the 2020-2021 USBC Rule Book. The tournament Committee will be responsible for all final decisions.
- 13 All scholarships will be held by the S.M.A.R.T. Program. Scholarship fees will be returned 100% based on ratio 1:10 minimum.
- 14 Note: Top U12 (DOB must be after 7/31/2011) boy & girl placing below the regular prize list will receive a scholarship.

**AN AWARDS CEREMONY WILL FOLLOW THE COMPLETION OF BOWLING**

**SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING COVID-19 AND THIS TOURNAMENT - Restrictions may be added or deleted closer to tournament date based on current standing.**

- We will abide by current mitigation policies in effect as of the date of the tournament. Masks will be required of **all persons in the building** at all times (unless revised at tournament time)
- At this time we can only allow ONE spectator per youth bowler in the building.
- Any other COVID related rules will be sent to bowlers who have registered via email. As this is a fluid situation, these can change at anytime. Any who fail to follow guidelines will be warned and removed from the lanes/building. No refunds will be given for players removed for COVID reason(s).
